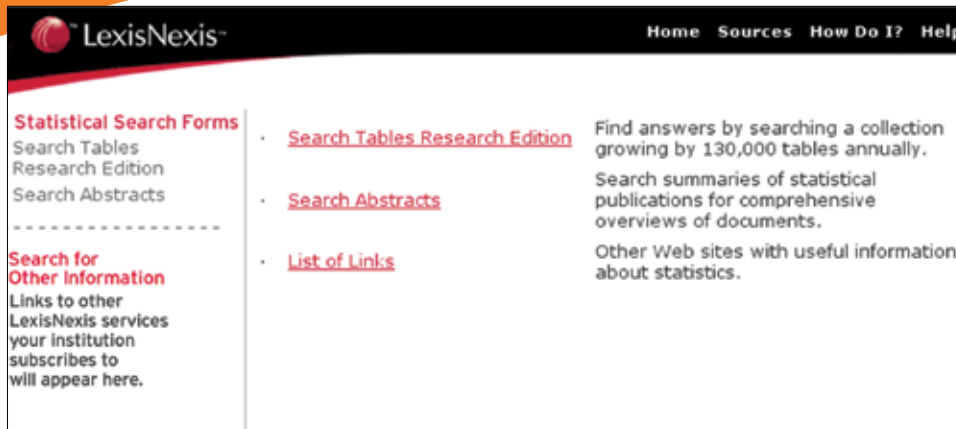

SRI abstracts and indexes significant statistical publications of state and private sector sources in the U.S. dating back to 1980. These sources include professional and trade associations, business organizations, commercial publishers, independent research organizations, state governments, and universities.

Index to International Statistics

IIS abstracts and indexes key statistical titles from international intergovernmental organizations dating back to 1983. Among these organizations are the United Nations, the European Union, the Organization for Economic Cooperation and Development, the World Bank, leading commodity organizations, and more.
